



## FUTURE OF WORLD TRADE CENTER SITE, ADJACENT AREAS AND RELATED TRANSPORTATION INFRASTRUCTURE

### *Public Input Process and Timeline*

#### **PHASE I – PA/LMDC Study of Options for World Trade Center Site, Adjacent Areas and Related Transportation Infrastructure**

***Third week of May:*** LMDC/Port Authority announce successful RFP respondent to conduct three-phase study of options for World Trade Center site, adjacent areas and related transportation infrastructure.

- ***May 23:*** Joint Port Authority/LMDC public hearing on options for World Trade Center site, adjacent areas and related transportation infrastructure, including options described in *LMDC Draft Principles and Preliminary Blueprint*.
- ***May 27:*** Final day for public comment on *LMDC Draft Principles and Preliminary Blueprint*.
- ***June 5:*** LMDC issues revised *Principles and Preliminary Blueprint*.
- ***June 5 through third week of July:*** Continuing outreach to public officials; Community Board 1; civic, planning, community organizations; and transportation groups, including those representing New York/New Jersey PATH commuters.
- ***June 10 through June 26:*** Meetings with LMDC Advisory Councils, LMDC General Advisory Council & State Senate Majority Task Force on WTC Recovery. Advisory Councils include Families; Residents; Commuters and Transportation; Restaurants, Retailers and Small Business; Arts, Education and Tourism; Financial and Professional Firms.
- ***June 26:*** Final day for public comments leading up to Phase I of RFP.
- ***Early to mid July:*** LMDC announces memorial design process.

***Early to mid July:*** Release of Phase I - LMDC/Port Authority Options for World Trade Center Site, Adjacent Areas and Related Transportation Infrastructure/summary of public comments.

#### **Phase I Public Comment Period – mid July through August 19**

- ***Third week of July:*** “*Listening to the City II*,” large-scale public forum.
- ***July 22 through August 7:*** Solicit input regarding Phase I from public officials; Community Board 1; civic, planning and community groups; transportation groups, including those representing New York/New Jersey PATH commuters; State Senate Majority Task Force on WTC Recovery, and LMDC Advisory Councils. Advisory Councils include Families; Residents; Commuters and Transportation; Restaurants, Retailers and Small Business; Arts, Education and Tourism; Financial and Professional Firms; LMDC General Advisory Council.
- ***First week of August:*** Public hearing in Lower Manhattan on Phase I.
- ***August 19:*** Final day for public comment on Phase I.

- **August 19 through mid September:** Consideration of public comments by LMDC/Port Authority.
- **August 19 through mid September:** Continuing conversations and updates with public officials; Community Board 1; civic, planning and community organizations; transportation groups, including those representing New York/New Jersey PATH commuters; State Senate Majority Task Force on WTC Recovery; and LMDC Advisory Councils. Advisory Councils include Families; Residents; Commuters and Transportation; Restaurants, Retailers and Small Business; Arts, Education and Tourism; Financial and Professional Firms; LMDC General Advisory Council.

**PHASE II – PA/LMDC Study of Options for World Trade Center Site, Adjacent Areas and Related Transportation Infrastructure**

**Mid to late September:** Release of Phase II- LMDC/Port Authority Options for World Trade Center Site, Adjacent Areas and Related Transportation Infrastructure/summary of public comments.

**Phase II Public Comment Period – September 30 through October 31**

- **October 1 through October 31:** Solicit input regarding Phase II from public officials, Community Board 1, civic, planning and community groups; transportation groups, including those representing New York/New Jersey PATH commuters; State Senate Majority Task Force on WTC Recovery; and LMDC Advisory Councils. Advisory Councils include Families; Residents; Commuters and Transportation; Restaurants, Retailers and Small Business; Arts, Education and Tourism; Financial and Professional Firms; LMDC General Advisory Council.
- **First week of October:** Public hearing in Lower Manhattan on Phase II.
- **Second week of October:** Public hearing in Lower Manhattan on Phase II.
- **October 31:** Final day for public comment on Phase II.
- **October 31 through December 19:** Consideration of public comments by Port Authority/LMDC.
- **October 31 through December 19:** Continuing conversations and updates with public officials; Community Board 1; civic, planning and community organizations; and transportation groups, including those representing New York/New Jersey PATH commuters; State Senate Majority Task Force on WTC Recovery; and LMDC Advisory Councils. Advisory Councils include Families; Residents; Commuters and Transportation; Restaurants, Retailers and Small Business; Arts, Education and Tourism; Financial and Professional Firms; LMDC General Advisory Council.

**PHASE III – PA/LMDC Study of Options for World Trade Center Site, Adjacent Areas and Related Transportation Infrastructure**

**Mid December:** Release of Phase III- LMDC/Port Authority Options for World Trade Center Site, Adjacent Areas and Related Transportation Infrastructure/summary of public comments.

**Post January 2003 Targets**

- Conduct outreach to public officials; Community Board 1; civic, planning and community organizations; transportation groups, including those representing New York/New Jersey PATH commuters; State Senate Majority Task Force on WTC Recovery; and LMDC Advisory Councils.
- Hold public hearings and forums.
- Amend Phase III based on public comment.
