NYMTC's Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) establishes a shared, long-term vision for the transportation system serving the New York metropolitan region. Updated every four years, the RTP is the product of a cooperative public involvement and intergovernmental planning process, and its approval by NYMTC's members is required for Federal transportation funding. NYMTC is a regional council of governments that is the metropolitan planning organization for New York City, Long Island and the lower Hudson Valley. The Environmental Justice (EJ) assessment is intended to assist NYMTC members with addressing the transportation issues pertaining to EJ & Title VI.

We invite you to examine these draft documents in detail (see below) and offer your input at these public outreach forums, as we look forward to the adoption of the final Plan later this year.
